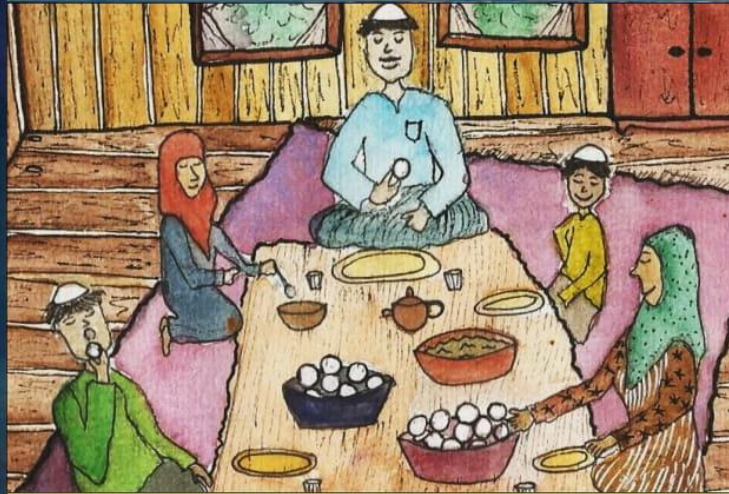

REDANG ISLAND ON THE EAST OF PENINSULAR MALAYSIA IS AN IMPORTANT NESTING SITE FOR SEA TURTLES



SEA TURTLES ARE ENDANGERED MARINE REPTILES. THEY MIGRATE FOR 100s OF KILOMETRES TO REACH THEIR NESTING SITES AND TAKE UP TO 50 YEARS TO MATURE



IT IS ESTIMATED THAT ONLY ONE IN A THOUSAND EGGS MAKE IT TO ADULTHOOD

FOR CENTURIES, THE LOCALS HAVE CONSUMED SEA TURTLE EGGS FOR ITS CULTURAL & MEDICINAL VALUE



THE CONSUMPTION OF SEA TURTLE EGGS IN MALAYSIA IS CONSIDERED TO BE A MAJOR THREAT

IN THE PAST, THE COMMUNITY DEPENDED ON SEA TURTLE EGGS THROUGH LICENSED COLLECTION



IN 2004, FIVE TURTLE SANCTUARIES WERE SET UP & LICENSED EGG COLLECTION WAS STOPPED

AN AWARENESS PROGRAM FOR CHILDREN WAS CONDUCTED



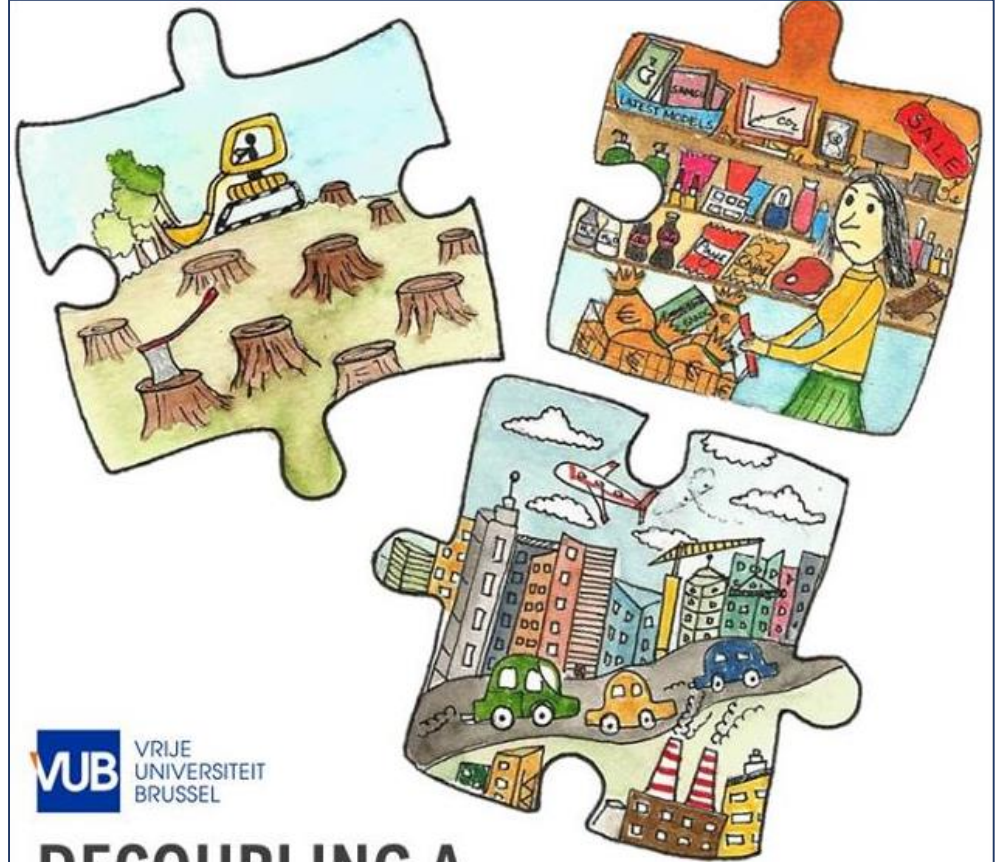

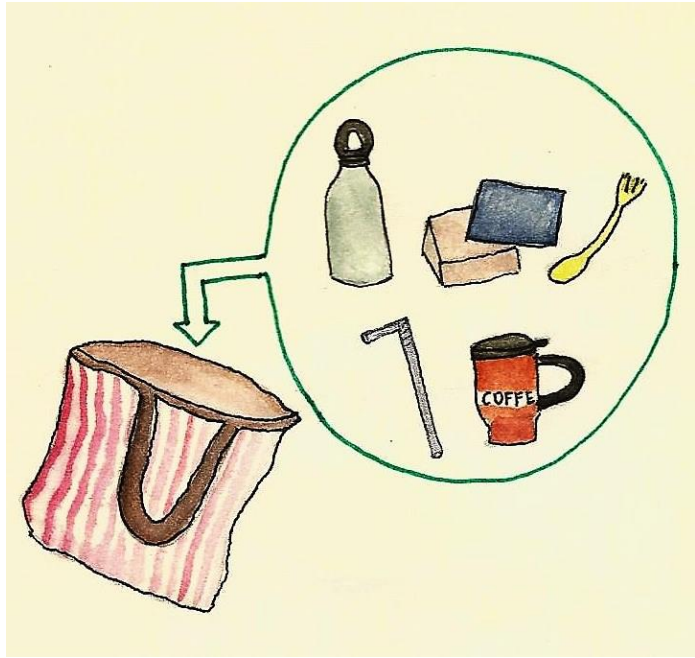

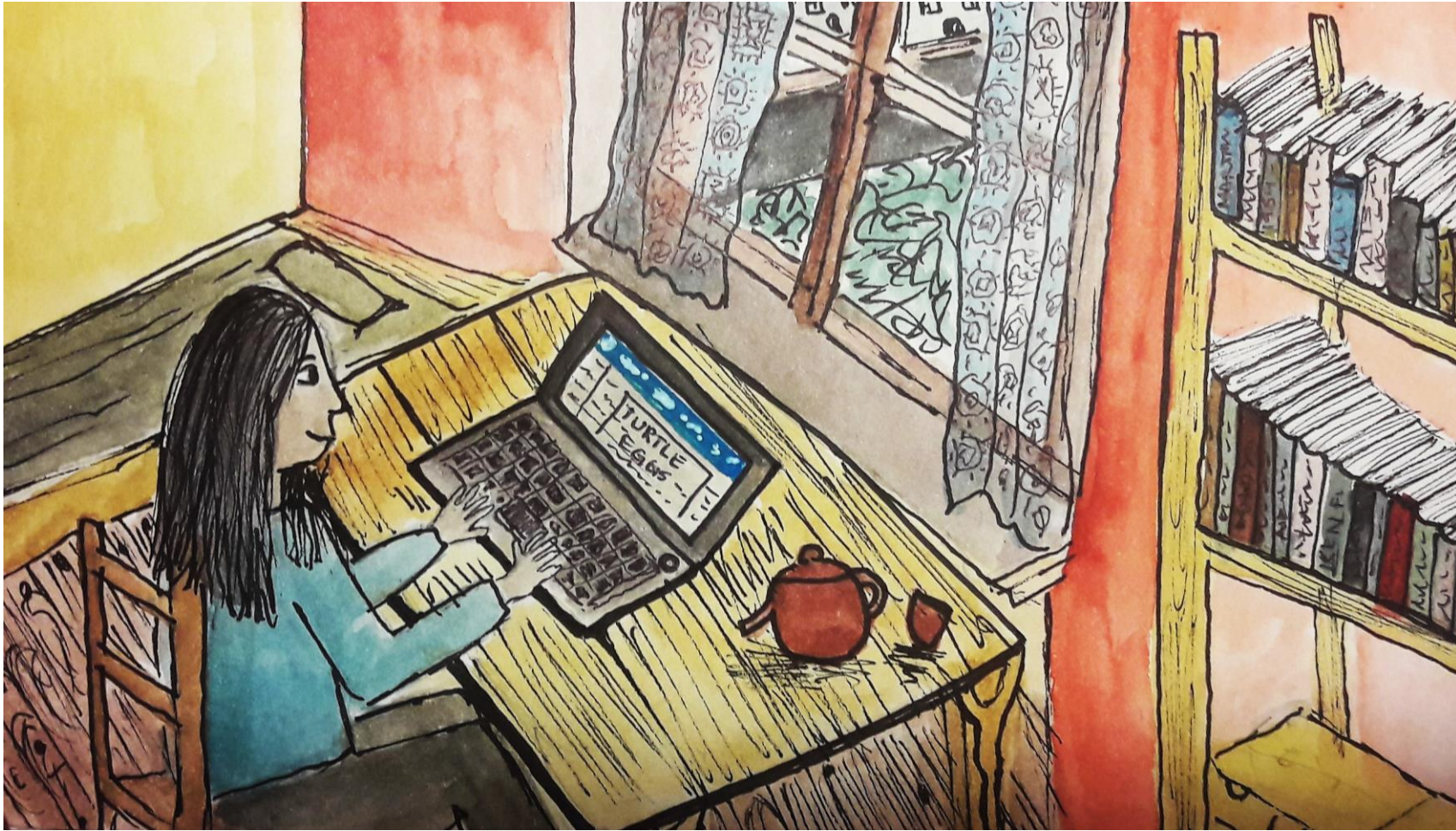
